

Guest Information Sheet

Sanctuary Rules

- All visits to the sanctuary must be scheduled, including donation drops.
- You can schedule by contacting us by email or by the website link.
- All persons on the property must have a waiver signed.
- Close main gate behind you by crossing the chain over the post.
- If individuals are in their pens or coops, do not let them out without consent of Sanctuary personnel.
- Volunteers can bring guests with them when they come to volunteer but they must have a waiver form completed before entering the sanctuary.
- The back door leads to the mudroom of the house, please do not enter past the mudroom without consent of Sanctuary personnel.
- Any food in the plastic containers is reserved for mealtime, please do not hand out to the residents.
- All resident's personal space and boundaries must be respected. If an individual does not want to be touched, photographed, please respect their wishes.



Sanctuary Volunteers

- All potential volunteers must attend a Volunteer Orientation Tour prior to volunteering time.
- Orientation tours are held Saturdays and Sundays, and are subject to availability.
- Group orientation tours are scheduled on a case by case basis. If you plan on having more than 4 people in your group please email about scheduling your tour.
- There is no minimum age for a sanctuary volunteer. Any minors must be accompanied by a responsible adult while on the property.
- All volunteers must complete and sign a volunteer waiver form prior to volunteering time. Email the above-mentioned contact for a waiver.
- Waivers are sent digitally. They are also fillable on your computer. You can simply download the attachment and fill out on your computer and email back to us. Save the file under the name the waiver is for.
- All persons interested in volunteering must have a waiver signed.
 This includes minors. For minors, a parent or legal guardian must fill out the waiver and sign for them.
- Once you have completed your orientation tour, you are able to come volunteer your time whenever you would like.
- Volunteers who have completed the above steps must use a link available on our website to schedule the time they wish to volunteer every time they want to come out. The link can be found at https://www.lamuellasanctuary.org/get-involved. Click the "Book Now" button and follow the instructions.
- You can only schedule service time once an orientation tour has been completed.
